database
collection of data organized according to a conceptual structure describing the characteristics of the data and the relationships among their corresponding entities, supporting one or more application areas.

A collection of interrelated data stored together in one or more computerized files.

database (DB)
A collection of interrelated data, often with controlled redundancy, organized according to a schema to serve one or more applications; the data are stored so that they can be used by different programs without concern for the data structure or organization. A common approach is used to add new data and to modify and retrieve existing data.

database service
Service officially operated under the rules of the local regulatory authority that provides a list of available channels and possibly the maximum EIRP allowable on these channels based on queries containing the geolocation of the Wireless Regional Area Network (WRAN) devices.
