Dear Counsel:

In accordance with *Sotera Wireless, Inc. v. Masimo Corp.*, IPR2020-00109, Paper 12 (Dec. 1, 2020), Resmed Corp. ("Resmed") hereby stipulates that if the Patent Trial and Appeal Board ("PTAB") institutes inter partes review in IPR2025-00157, IPR2025-00158, IPR2025-00159, IPR2025-00160, IPR2025-00246, and/or IPR2025-00247, then Resmed will not pursue in this case for the challenged claims of its corresponding patent the specific grounds of invalidity that were raised or grounds that reasonably could have been raised under 35 U.S.C. §§ 102 or 103 on the basis of prior art patents or printed publications in the respective instituted IPR(s).

For the avoidance of doubt, if the PTAB declines institution or rescinds institution of the IPR, then Resmed reserves the right to pursue any grounds of invalidity available for the patent.
