**PATENT OWNER'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR
WITHDRAWAL OF COUNSEL JOSEPH F. HAAG
PURSUANT TO 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(e)**

I. STATEMENT OF RELIEF REQUESTED

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(e), and as authorized in the Board’s email of August 29, 2025, Patent Owner Skyworks Solutions respectfully requests that the Board authorize withdrawal of Joseph Haag as counsel in this proceeding, IPR2025-00373.¹ Patent Owner has conferred with Petitioner, and Petitioner does not oppose this motion.

II. STATEMENT OF FACTS SHOWING GOOD CAUSE FOR WITHDRAWAL OF COUNSEL JOSEPH F. HAAG

Counsel Joseph Haag is no longer affiliated with Wilmer Cutler Pickering Hale & Dorr LLP as of August 1, 2025. Given Mr. Haag’s departure from the firm, Patent Owner requests that Mr. Haag be deemed withdrawn from the present proceeding. As set forth in Patent Owner’s Updated Mandatory Notice Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(b)(3) filed on July 21, 2025, Ms. Haixia Lin will represent Patent Owner as lead counsel and Mr. Danny S. Perry and Mr. Jungyeon Kim will represent Patent Owner as backup counsel. *See* Paper 11. Ms. Lin, Mr. Perry, and Mr. Kim are all of Wilmer Cutler Pickering Hale & Dorr LLP.

¹ Patent Owner is concurrently filing an unopposed motion to withdraw Joseph Haag as counsel for Patent Owner in IPR2024-01456, 1457 and IPR2025-00372, 912.

Reasonable steps have been taken to “avoid foreseeable prejudice to the rights of the client, including giving due notice to [the] client . . . ,” and through Ms. Lin as lead counsel and Mr. Perry and Mr. Kim as backup counsel. *See* 37 C.F.R. § 10.40(a). Furthermore, no changes to the schedule will be needed based on this motion. Therefore, Patent Owner believes that granting this motion will not hinder “the economy, the integrity of the patent system, the efficient administration of the Office, and the ability of the Office to timely complete [this] proceeding[.]” *See* 35 U.S.C. § 316(b).

III. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Patent Owner respectfully requests that the Board authorize withdrawal of Joseph F. Haag as counsel in this proceeding.
