**ORAL ORDER:** Pursuant to the Court's May 20, 2021 Report and Recommendation recommending that the pending motions to dismiss be granted-in-part and denied-in-part, (D.I. [279]), the Court hereby **ORDERS** as follows: (1) The stay of the case with respect to the CERT Defendants and Moving Refined Coal Defendants is hereby lifted.; (2) By no later than May 21, 2021, Plaintiffs shall file the Second Amended Complaint.; (3) By no later than May 27, 2021, the parties shall meet and confer and submit a proposed amended Scheduling Order. If there are disputed issues between the parties regarding the content of the proposed amended Scheduling Order, the parties should note those areas of dispute in the proposed amended Scheduling Order, along with their proposals for the language the Court should adopt as to that issue.
