The parties jointly write to notify the Board that they have reached a settlement agreement and have agreed to seek a 45-day stay of IPR2025-00502, IPR2025-00503, and IPR2025-00512 to allow them to finalize the settlement and jointly seek to terminate the proceedings. Patent Owner's preliminary responses and Petitioner's oppositions to Patent Owner's requests for discretionary denial were filed on May 27, 2025.
