Linkplay Technology Inc. and Linkplay Technology, Inc., Nanjing (collectively “Linkplay”) agrees that if IPR2025-00511 is instituted, Linkplay will not pursue in the related District Court Litigation (*Sonos, Inc. v. Linkplay Technology Inc.*, Case no. 1:24-cv-00131 (D. Del.)) the following invalidity challenges to U.S. Patent No. 9,213,357 relying on 35 U.S.C. §§ 102, 103: (1) any ground raised or that could have been reasonably raised in IPR2025-00511, as well as (2) any ground based on corresponding system prior art. *See Sotera Wireless, Inc. v. Masimo Corp.*, IPR2020-01019, Paper 12 at 18-19 (PTAB Dec. 1, 2020) (Precedential).
