ORAL ORDER: ORDER. The Court resolves the parties' discovery disputes memorialized in the letters dated 4/29/2025 and 5/1/2025, as follows. First, as to Interrogatory No. 20, the Court compels Sonos to respond to the interrogatory, as narrowed. The narrowed interrogatory seeks discoverable information on invalidity defenses; to the extent that those subjects touch on inequitable conduct, the discovery requests are tied to the pled bases of that defense. Second, as to RFP Nos. 136 and 137, the Court denies the Linkplay Defendants' request, and finds that Sonos has sufficiently responded to those requests. Asking for all discovery in other related cases is generally overbroad; the fact that Sonos has already produced the construction, invalidity, and expert reports from those cases is more than sufficient to respond to the requests in an appropriate and non-overbroad manner.
