Applicant noted that portions of the Arora reference identified by the Examiner fail to teach or suggest at least some limitations of the allowed claims, such as the "identifying" limitation of claim 1. The Examiner agreed that the allowed claims appear to be allowable over the Arora reference pending his further consideration.
