February 6, 2026	All parties serve rebuttal expert reports
March 13, 2026	Completion of expert discovery

April 3, 2026	Last day to file <i>Daubert</i> motions
April 3, 2026	Last day to file case dispositive motions
April 22, 2026	Responses to <i>Daubert</i> motions
April 22, 2026	Responses to case dispositive motions
May 6, 2026	Replies to <i>Daubert</i> motions
May 6, 2026	Replies to case dispositive motions
At the Court's convenience	Summary judgment hearing
After the Court has set a final pretrial conference, the parties will identify a schedule for serving a joint final pretrial order that includes exhibit and witness lists, deposition designations, proposed jury instructions, a verdict form, and any objections and rebuttals thereto. The parties will also identify a schedule for filing an omnibus motion in limine.	Serve pretrial disclosures
