**ORDER**

Before the Court is the Joint Motion to Stay All Deadlines and Notice of Settlement (the “Motion”) filed by Plaintiff KAIFI LLC and Defendants Amazon.com, Inc., Amazon.com Services LLC, and Amazon Web Services, Inc. (collectively, the “Parties”). (Dkt. No. 113.) In the Motion, the Parties represent that all matters in controversy between them have settled, in principle. (*Id.* at 1.) The Parties request that the Court stay for forty-five (45) days the unreachd deadlines contained in the Court’s Docket Control Order (taking into account intervening holidays and the corporate summer schedule) so that the Parties may complete the memorialization of their agreement in principle and submit appropriate dismissal papers. (*Id.*)

Having considered the Motion, and noting its joint nature, the Court finds that it should be and hereby is **GRANTED**. Accordingly, all deadlines are **STAYED** for forty-five (45) days, during which time appropriate dismissal papers are to be filed with the Court.
