**PETITIONER'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR
PRO HAC VICE ADMISSION OF ZHE WANG
UNDER 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)**

I. RELIEF REQUESTED

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §42.10(c), Petitioner OnePlus Technology (Shenzhen) Co., Ltd. (“OnePlus”) requests that the Board admit Zhe “Philip” Wang’s *pro hac vice* as back-up counsel for OnePlus in this proceeding.

II. STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Board may recognize counsel *pro hac vice* subject to the conditions set forth in 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c) and any other that the Board may impose. Petitioner sets forth the following facts in support of this motion:

1. Counsel for Petitioner has contacted counsel for Patent Owner, who indicated that Patent Owner does not oppose Mr. Wang’s admission *pro hac vice*.
2. Lead counsel for OnePlus in this proceeding, Zhiwei (Wayne) Zou, is a registered practitioner, Reg. No. 66,041.
3. Mr. Wang is a member in good standing of the State Bar of Texas, and is admitted to practice before the United States District Court for the Southern District of Texas, the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas, and the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit (Exhibit 1018).
4. Mr. Wang has never been suspended or disbarred from practice before any court or administrative body.
5. Mr. Wang has never had an application for admission to practice before any court or administrative body denied.

6. Mr. Wang has never had sanctions or contempt citations imposed on him by any court or administrative body.

7. Mr. Wang has attested that he has read and will comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials set forth in 37 C.F.R. § 42.

8. Mr. Wang understands that he will be subject to the USPTO Code of Professional Responsibility set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 et seq. and disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a).

9. Mr. Wang has previously been granted *pro hac vice* appearance before the Patent Trial and Appeal Board in the following proceedings:

- a. *Guangdong OPPO Mobile Telecommunications Corp., Ltd. v. Nokia Solutions and Networks Oy*, IPR2022-00632

10. Mr. Wang is an experienced patent litigator in all phases of patent litigation.

11. Mr. Wang has spent a substantial amount of time examining the '283 Patent and pertinent prior art, and thus has an established familiarity with the subject matter at issue in this proceeding.

III. GOOD CAUSE EXISTS FOR *PRO HAC VICE* ADMISSION

The facts outlined in the above Statement of Facts, and contained in the Declaration by Zhe Wang, establish that there is good cause to admit Mr. Wang *pro hac vice* in this proceeding pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §42.10(c).

Lead counsel, Mr. Zou, is a registered practitioner, Mr. Wang is an experienced patent litigator, and Mr. Wang has an established familiarity with the patent at issue in the proceeding.

IV. CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, OnePlus respectfully requests that the Board grant Mr. Wang *pro hac vice* in this proceeding.
