**DECLARATION OF MATTHEW D. POWERS IN SUPPORT OF PATENT  
OWNER'S MOTION FOR *PRO HAC VICE* ADMISSION**

I, MATTHEW D. POWERS, declare as follows:

1. I am a member in good standing of the State Bar of California as well as the bars of the United States Courts of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, and the United States Supreme Court.

I am also admitted to practice in the following United States District Courts: the Northern, Southern, Central, and Eastern Districts of California; the Eastern and Western Districts of Texas; the Northern District of Indiana; the Eastern District of Michigan; and the Western District of Wisconsin.

2. I have not been suspended or disbarred from practice before any court or administrative body.

3. I have never had an application for admission to practice before any court or administrative body denied.

4. No sanction or contempt citation has been imposed against me by any court or administrative body.

5. I have read and will comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials set forth in Part 42 of 37 C.F.R.

6. I will be subject to the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 et seq. and disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a).

7. I applied to appear *pro hac vice* before the Office in Proceeding Nos. IPR2021-00133, IPR2022-00370, IPR2022-00371, IPR2022-00489, IPR2022-00490 IPR2020-00715, IPR2020-00712, IPR2020-00680, IPR2020-00679, IPR2024-00810, IPR2024-00856, IPR2025-00296, and IPR2025-00297 in the last three years. All motions were either granted or, in the case of IPR2021-00133, IPR2022-00489, IPR2022-00490, IPR2022-00370, and IPR2022-00371, not decided. In IPR2021-00133, the parties filed a joint motion to terminate proceedings about three and a half weeks after the *pro hac vice* motion was filed. In IPR2022-00489, IPR2022-00490, IPR2022-00370, and IPR2022-00371, the proceedings were never instituted and instead were terminated following a joint motion to terminate by the parties. I am also concurrently applying to appear *pro hac vice* in Proceeding No. IPR2025-00708, IPR2025-00710, IPR2025-00711, IPR2025-00712, and IPR2025-00713.

8. I am an experienced litigation attorney with approximately thirty-seven years of experience representing clients in patent cases involving a variety of technologies. I litigate patent cases in U.S. District Courts, the International Trade Commission, and the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, and have litigated also before the International Chamber of Commerce. Through my experience in patent litigation matters, I have represented clients in all phases of

litigation including fact discovery, expert discovery, *Markman* hearings, jury trials, bench trials, trials before administrative law judges, and appeals before the United States Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit. I am one of the founding partners of Tensegrity Law Group LLP, a law firm specializing in patent litigation, trials, and appellate matters. Prior to forming Tensegrity, I was a managing partner at Weil, Gotshal & Manges LLP. My biography is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

9. I have an established familiarity with the subject matter at issue in this proceeding. I am trial counsel for Milestone Entertainment, LLC, the Patent Owner in this proceeding, in the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California, Case No. 2:24-cv-04506-AB (SSCx), which involves the same patent (U.S. Patent No. 10,650,635) and the same references identified in the Petition in this proceeding as the grounds for challenge. I have reviewed and am familiar with U.S. Patent No. 10,650,635 at issue in this proceeding, the Petition and supporting exhibits in this proceeding, the art presented in the Petition, and the legal and factual issues raised in this proceeding. As a result, I have a substantial understanding of the underlying legal and technological issues at stake in this proceeding.

10. I hereby declare that all statements made herein of my own knowledge are true and that all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true; and further that these statements were made with the knowledge that willful

false statements and the like so made are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under Section 1001 of Title 18 of the United States Code.

Matt Powers is known for taking tough cases to trial and winning them. He tries patent cases, trade secret cases, fraud cases, fiduciary duty cases, antitrust cases and contract cases. Managing Intellectual Property magazine also named him "Outstanding IP Practitioner of the Year" in 2010. He was named one of Northern California's top ten lawyers in 2009 by Super Lawyers.
