noun: **string**

1. material consisting of threads of cotton, hemp, or other material twisted together to form a thin length.

"unwieldy packs tied up with string"

Similar: twine cord yarn thread strand fiber rope cable line

- a piece of string used to tie around or attach to something.
plural noun: **strings**
"the elephant mask had a trunk you could raise by pulling a string"
- a piece of catgut or similar material interwoven with others to form the head of a sports racket.
- a length of catgut or wire on a musical instrument, producing a note by vibration.
"the D string broke"
- the stringed instruments in an orchestra.
plural noun: **strings**
"the blend of the wind-group is less perfect than that of the strings"

Similar: stringed instruments

- relating to or consisting of stringed instruments.
modifier noun: **string**
"a string quartet"

2. a set of things tied or threaded together on a thin cord.
"she wore a **string** of agates around her throat"

Similar: strand rope necklace rosary chaplet

- a sequence of similar items or events.
"a **string** of burglaries"
Similar: series succession chain sequence concatenation run
- COMPUTING**
a linear sequence of characters, words, or other data.
- a group of racehorses trained at one stable.
- a team or player holding a specified position in an order of preference.
"Gary was first string on the varsity football team"

3. a tough piece of fiber in vegetables, meat, or other food, such as a tough elongated piece connecting the two halves of a bean pod.

4. short for stringboard.

5. **PHYSICS**
a hypothetical one-dimensional subatomic particle having the dynamical properties of a flexible loop.

- a hypothetical threadlike concentration of energy within the structure of space-time.
noun: **cosmic string**; plural noun: **cosmic strings**

verb: **string**; 3rd person present: **strings**; past tense: **strung**; past participle: **strung**; gerund or present participle: **stringing**

1. hang (something) so that it stretches in a long line.
"lights were strung across the promenade"

Similar: hang suspend sling stretch thread loop festoon run

- thread (a series of small objects) on a string.
"he collected stones with holes in them and strung them on a strong cord"

Similar: thread loop link join

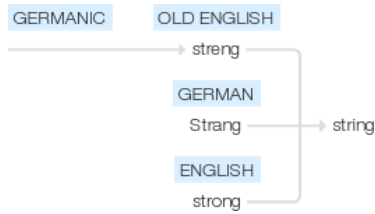

Old English *streng* (noun), of Germanic origin; related to German *Strang*, also to strong. The verb (dating from late Middle English) is first recorded in the senses 'arrange in a row' and 'fit with a string'.
