Petitioner respectfully requests, for good cause, authorization to make of record in IPR proceedings IPR2025-00720 and -00756 the attached Order recently granting a stay of the parallel litigation. *Pantech Corp. v. OnePlus Tech. (Shenzhen) Co., Ltd.*, 5:24-cv-00038 (E.D. Tex. Sept. 29, 2025) (Dkt. No. 112). The Court’s granting of the stay is directly relevant to at least *Fintiv* factors 1 and 2. We understand that the Director has allowed the Order to be made of record in related IPR proceedings IPR2025-00887 and -00888.
