I recently initiated Director Review in the above-referenced proceedings. In light of the precedential decision in *Revvo Technologies, Inc. v. Cerebrum Sensor Technologies, Inc.*, IPR2025-00632, Paper 20 (Director Nov. 3, 2025), and the informative decision in *Tesla, Inc. v. Intellectual Ventures II LLC*, IPR2025-00340, Paper 18 (Director Nov. 5, 2025), which address a petitioner's different claim construction positions in district court and before the Board, I have determined that additional briefing is appropriate. The parties are authorized to file an additional brief in each proceeding that addresses the impact of the *Revvo* and *Tesla* decisions on these proceedings in view of Petitioner's claim construction positions. Briefing may not address other issues, and no new evidence is permitted without separate authorization.

Accordingly, it is:

ORDERED that Petitioner and Patent Owner are authorized to file an additional brief in each proceeding addressing the impact of the *Revvo* and *Tesla* decisions as provided above; and

FURTHER ORDERED that each brief may not exceed five (5) pages and will be due no later than close of business on December 22, 2025.
