In light of the recent precedential decision in *Revvo Technologies, Inc. v. Cerebrum Sensor Technologies, Inc.*, IPR2025-00632, Paper 20 (Nov. 3, 2025), and the recent informative decision in *Tesla, Inc. v. Intellectual Ventures II LLC*, IPR2025-00340, Paper 18 (Nov. 5, 2025)), which address a petitioner's different claim construction positions in district court and at the Board, the parties are authorized to file an additional brief in each of the above-referenced proceedings to address the impact of the *Revvo* and *Tesla* decisions on these proceedings in view of Petitioner's claim construction positions.
