**PATENT OWNER'S MOTION FOR *PRO HAC VICE* ADMISSION OF
MICHAEL H. BUNIS UNDER 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)**

Patent Owner respectfully requests that the Board recognize Michael H. Bunis as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Patent Owner seeks the counsel of Mr. Bunis due to his experience in patent-related matters, litigation proceedings, and his familiarity with the substantive and technical issues involved in this case.

depositions of, and otherwise worked with numerous companies, with respect to various technology fields.

Mr. Bunis' biography is attached as Appendix A to the Declaration of Michael H. Bunis in Support of Patent Owner's Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission (EX2037). Mr. Bunis is also familiar with the subject matter at issue in this proceeding. He has invested a significant amount of time in reviewing and analyzing relevant materials as counsel of record for Patent Owner in the parallel district court proceeding, *Progenics Pharms., Inc. v.
