U.S. PATENT NOS. 7,219,027, 7,970,059, AND 8,291,236**



**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that this action is **BIFURCATED** with respect to claims related to Counts IV (the '027 Patent), VI (the '059 Patent), and VII (the '236 Patent) (collectively, the "Bifurcated Claims").

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Bifurcated Claims are **STAYED** pending completion of trial with respect to the remaining counts of infringement directed toward U.S. Patent Nos. 7,769,238, 8,139,878, and 8,208,542.
