JOINT MOTION TO TERMINATE PROCEEDING

Pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 317(a) and 37 C.F.R. § 42.72, Petitioner Mercedes-Benz Group, AG (“**Mercedes**”) and Patent Owner The Phelan Group, LLC (“**Phelan**”) jointly request termination of this proceeding, IPR2025-00930, challenging claims of U.S. Patent No. 11,472,427 (the “427 Patent”) as a result of a Settlement Agreement that resolves all pending disputes between Mercedes and Phelan. The Board authorized filing of this Joint Motion to Terminate via email on November 25, 2025. Mercedes and Phelan are filing substantively identical motions to terminate in six other IPR proceedings involving related patents, that are similarly resolved by the Settlement Agreement. These are:

Mercedes and Phelan are filing concurrently herewith a request that the Settlement Agreement, filed as EX1017, be kept confidential and separate from the file pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 317(b) and 37 C.F.R. § 42.74(c).

Mercedes filed its petition for *inter partes* review on April 25, 2025. The Board instituted *inter partes* review on November 21, 2025. (Paper 9.) Since

institution, a Settlement Agreement has been reached which resolves all underlying disputes between Mercedes and Phelan, including those related to this proceeding and the underlying district court case.¹ The parties do not anticipate further litigation between them concerning the '427 Patent. A true and correct copy of the Settlement Agreement is being filed herewith as EX1017. Mercedes and Phelan certify that there are no collateral agreements or understandings between them made in connection with, or in contemplation of, termination of this proceeding.

The Board should terminate this IPR because the proceeding is still in its very early stages, the Patent Owner has yet to file a Patent Owner Response, and no final written decision has issued. As the Board has recognized, early termination—particularly when unopposed—promotes efficiency and substantially conserves the Board's and parties' resources. Termination is also appropriate because public policy favors terminating the present petition for inter partes review. For example, the Board's Trial Practice Guide acknowledges that “[t]here are strong public policy reasons to favor settlement between the parties to a proceeding.” Consolidated Office Patent Trial Practice Guide, at 86 (Nov. 2019).

For the foregoing reasons, Mercedes and Phelan respectfully request
