**ORDER NO. 18: GRANTING MOTION TO SUSPEND THE PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE FOR THE SONY RESPONDENTS**

(August 11, 2025)

Complainant AX Wireless LLC and respondents Sony Interactive Entertainment Inc. and Sony Interactive Entertainment LLC (collectively, Sony) jointly move to suspend the procedural schedule through August 22, 2025, “to allow [the parties] sufficient time to prepare a formal settlement agreement prior to filing a motion to terminate the investigation.” Motion Docket No. 1445-013 at 1 (EDIS Doc. ID 859109).¹ The motion represents that the remaining respondents and Commission Investigative Staff do not oppose. *Id.* at 2.

AX Wireless and Sony state that they have reached an agreement in principle to settle their dispute and will file a termination motion after they execute a final agreement. *Id.* at 1. They note that Order No. 16 (EDIS Doc. ID 858625) granted a suspension of the procedural schedule for the remaining (Vantiva) respondents through August 15, 2025, based on a similar representation that AX Wireless and Vantiva had reached a settlement agreement in principle and that a termination motion is forthcoming. *Id.* AX Wireless and Sony also state that a suspension will conserve Commission and party resources and that similar requests have been granted before. *Id.* at 2, *citing*,

e.g., Certain Wireless Devices with 3G and/or 4G Capabilities and Components Thereof, Inv. No. 337-TA-868, Order No. 87 (Jan. 6, 2014) (EDIS Doc. ID 525201).

Lacking opposition and for good cause shown, Motion No. 1445-013 is GRANTED. The procedural schedule is suspended as to the Sony respondents through August 22, 2025. The claim construction hearing scheduled for August 13, 2025 is canceled.
