## A Long-Term Innovation Path

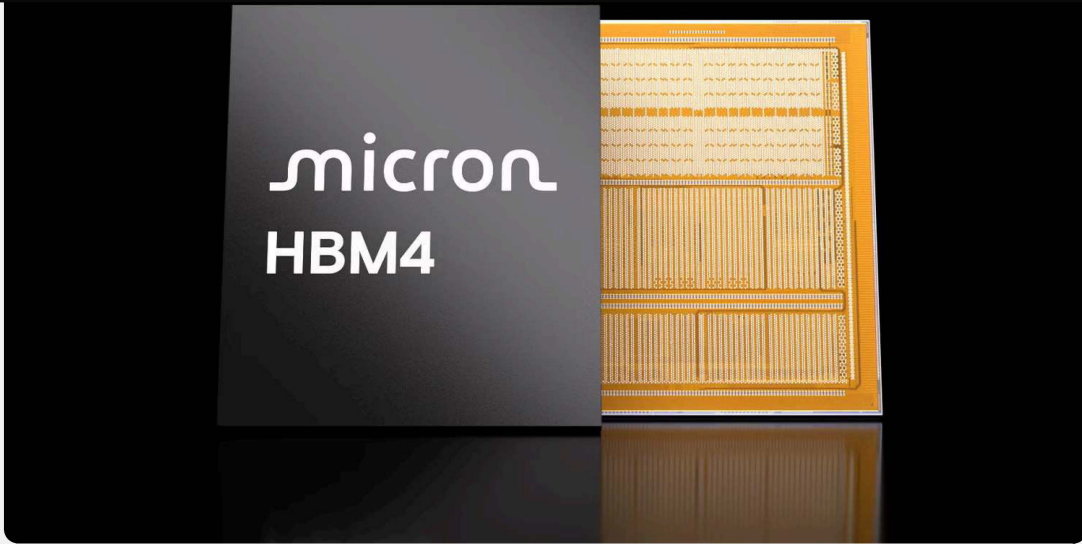
