formal

in a way that involves things happening or being done at the same time or speed:

- *Dragonflies beat their two sets of wings synchronously.*
- *The predator eggs hatch synchronously with the emergence of the wasp larvae.*

EDUCATION • specialized

with a teacher and students taking part in a lesson at the same time, either physically together in one place, or using the internet:

- *Students can study synchronously or asynchronously.*
- *Small-group and one-to-one teacher-learner interaction, both synchronously and asynchronously, forms part of this learning system.*



Fewer examples

- *The female-pup bond is especially important to creatures that rear their young synchronously in high-density breeding colonies.*

Thus, minicolumns aligned in parallel and *synchronously* active make the largest contribution to scalp potentials.

Neurons within each of these assemblies may fire *synchronously*, but they need not be synchronized to neurons of the other assemblies.
