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ORDER

Before the Court is the Motion for Issuance of Letter Rogatory to Nuvoton Technology Corporation Japan (Dkt. No. 115) filed by Defendant Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Company Ltd. (“TSMC”). In the Motion, TSMC asks the Court to issue a Request for Judicial Assistance (“Letter Rogatory”) addressed to the appropriate authorities of Japan seeking their support in obtaining documents and deposition testimony from Nuvoton Technology Corporation Japan. (*Id.* at 1). Plaintiff has not opposed the Motion.

Having considered the Motion, the Court finds that it should be and hereby is **GRANTED**. Further, the Court **APPROVES** the proposed Letter Rogatory, which is attached to the Motion (Dkt. No. 116-1). Accordingly, the Court will execute the Letter Rogatory with original signatures,

to which the Clerk of Court shall affix original seals. TSMC may retrieve the completed Letter Rogatory in-person from the Clerk of Court following the completion of this process.
