6. Please change Environments to Scenes; I think shorter can be better
7. "Cyberlink YouCam supports the recording of high-definition (1280x720) video if your webcam is capable of outputting this resolution (Edward, please help to comment on the resolution support, up to?)
8. Please add a * in Desktop Capture: such that in some version, Desktop Capture does not allow recording in standalone mode.
9. We need to mention somewhere that, if on lower performance platform, such as Atom platform, some features may not be applicable.
