Patent Owner's Notices of Intent to designate Colette Woo and Nathan Lowenstein pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)(2) in IPR2025-01200, IPR2025-01201, and IPR2025-01202 are acknowledged. Although these attorneys are included in earlier-filed mandatory notices, 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)(2)(iii) provides that updated mandatory notices need to be filed after the expiration of the applicable time period (5 or 10 business days) set forth in 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)(2)(iii), in order for each attorney to be deemed admitted. A previously filed mandatory notice that includes the pro hac vice attorneys does not meet 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)(2)(iii). Thus, after the applicable 5 or 10 business days, Patent Owner should file updated mandatory notices including Ms. Woo and Mr. Lowenstein under 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c)(2)(iii).
