Pursuant to the parties' agreement, we respectfully request approval for Patent Owner Sonos to refile its Request for Discretionary Denial under the newly established 20-page limit by Friday, September 19, 2025 and grant Petitioner Google a three-day extension to file its response by Monday, October 20, 2025. As part of that agreement, we also request that the originally filed Request for Discretionary Denial be expunged from the record.

Sonos originally submitted its Request on September 17 under the previously applicable 14,000-word limit outlined in the March 26 Memorandum. However, Sonos has since learned that the 14,000-word limit has been replaced with a 20-page limit.
