BOE's response is misdirection and distraction. It argues that "Beijing Opto-Electronics Technology Co.," listed on the entity list, is unaffiliated with Petitioner. Paper 12 at 1–2.¹ But Petitioner simply ignores the House Letter that specifically addresses BOE the display manufacturer. Ex. 2006 at 1 ("in order to protect U.S. national security interests, the [ITC] must ... ban imports of **BOE's patent infringing displays**" (emphasis added)). Petitioner does not deny that the House Letter refers to it and cannot substantively rebut the Congressional findings. *See* Paper 12 at 2. The House Committee is unequivocal that BOE's IP theft poses significant national security risks. Ex. 2006.² The House Committee expressly found that "**the PRC has groomed BOE** as its national champion in the display industry." *Id.* at 1. Petitioner's attempt to hide its PRC connections is flatly contradicted by what Congress has already found. The Board should adopt Congress's finding that BOE qualifies as a Chinese military company, is a national security threat, and has not disclosed all RPIs. The Board should therefore deny institution.
