

Seiko Epson: quitting small LCD ops is one option

TOKYO, March 11 (Reuters) - Japan's Seiko Epson Corp <6724.T> said on Wednesday that withdrawing from the small liquid crystal display (LCD) business would be one option as part of its restructuring.

Seiko Epson, which competes with Canon Inc <7751.T> in printers and Sharp Corp <6753.T> in small LCD displays, earlier widened its net loss estimate for the year ending March 31 to 100 billion yen (\$1 billion) from its earlier projection of 4 billion yen.
