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Dear Honorable Director and Honorable Board:

Petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the petitions in each of the above-referenced proceedings. In each of the proceedings, Petitioner Google LLC filed a petition to challenge a patent at issue in *ART Research and Technology v. Google, LLC, et al.*, Civ. Action No. 3:24-cv-04898 (N.D. Cal). On Friday, November 28, 2025, that district court entered a stipulated judgment and order declaring each of these four patents to be invalid as ineligible under 35 U.S.C. § 101.

Accordingly, Petitioner seeks leave to file a motion to withdraw the petition in each of these proceedings and to include the district court's order as an exhibit to the motion. Patent Owner has indicated that it does not oppose the motion.

This email is being sent to both the Director and the merits panel because three of these IPRs are pending before a Board panel, where the fourth is pending before the Director. Specifically, on October 16, 2025, IPR2025-01403, IPR2025-01404, and IPR2025-01405 were referred to a Board panel; however, as of December 9, 2025, the fourth IPR (IPR2025-01406) had not yet been expressly referred to a merits panel. As a result, it is Petitioner's understanding
