**PATENT OWNER BECKMAN COULTER, INC.'S UNOPPOSED MOTION  
FOR WITHDRAWAL OF COUNSEL ALEXIS R. COHEN  
PURSUANT TO 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(e)**

**I. STATEMENT OF RELIEF REQUESTED**

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(e), and as authorized in the Director's email of January 29, 2026, Patent Owner Beckman Coulter, Inc. respectfully requests that the Director authorize withdrawal of Alexis R. Cohen as counsel in this proceeding, PGR2025-00084.<sup>1</sup> Patent Owner has conferred with Petitioner, and Petitioner does not oppose this motion.

**II. STATEMENT OF FACTS SHOWING GOOD CAUSE FOR WITHDRAWAL OF COUNSEL ALEXIS R. COHEN**

Counsel Alexis R. Cohen is no longer affiliated with Wilmer Cutler Pickering Hale & Dorr LLP as of January 26, 2026. Given Ms. Cohen's departure from the firm, Patent Owner requests that Ms. Cohen be deemed withdrawn from the present proceeding. As set forth in Patent Owner's Updated Mandatory Notice Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(b)(3) and Power of Attorney under 37 C.F.R. § 10, each concurrently filed, Laura Macro, who formerly served as backup counsel, will represent Patent Owner as lead counsel, and all other backup counsel for Patent Owner will remain as backup counsel.

Reasonable steps have been taken to “avoid foreseeable prejudice to the rights of the client, including giving due notice to [the] client . . . ,” and through designating Laura Macro as lead counsel. *See* 37 C.F.R. § 10.40(a). Furthermore, no changes to the schedule will be needed based on this motion. Therefore, Patent Owner believes that granting this motion will not hinder “the economy, the integrity of the patent system, the efficient administration of the Office, and the ability of the Office to timely complete [this] proceeding[.]” *See* 35 U.S.C. § 316(b).

### **III. CONCLUSION**

For the foregoing reasons, Patent Owner respectfully requests that the Board authorize withdrawal of Alexis R. Cohen as counsel in this proceeding.
