To the Board:

The parties to this proceeding jointly request that the Board suspend and re-set the dates in this proceeding by 60 days. There is no opposition to this request.

The reason for the request, and the “good cause” required for such an extension of dates, is based on not only the fact that the parties are in serious settlement discussions (which in and of itself may not be sufficient), but also based on the nature of the settlement terms under discussion, which at a high level, contain some conditions precedent to be fulfilled prior to a settlement being finalized, and those conditions precedent are expect to take approximately 3-4 weeks.

More specifically, the proposed terms that are critical to reach settlement include several logistically complex procedures involving product testing for quality purposes and product inspection processes as well. Again, these procedures are expected to take approximately 3-4 weeks. Assuming that such testing and inspection proceed as the parties hope, the parties would then be in a position to finalize a written settlement agreement within several weeks thereafter. Accordingly, the parties believe that a 60 day extension of dates is needed and that there is good cause therefor.
