RE: Cease and Desist – Infringement of Patent Rights

Dear Mr. Carr,

I am writing on behalf of my client Nanjing Nutrabuilding Bio-Tech Co., Ltd. (NNB Nutrition), which holds granted patents related to dihydroberberine. It has come to our attention that Nature's Fusions is manufacturing, marketing, and selling a product under the name "Dihydroberberine +" on the Amazon platform, promoting it with claims relating to cardiovascular and metabolic health support. This product appears to infringe upon NNB's proprietary technology and patents for dihydroberberine-based compositions.

Patent Information:

NNB Nutrition holds exclusive rights to **U.S. Patent No. 10,278,961 B2** titled "**Administration of Berberine Metabolites**," which protects certain dihydroberberine formulations and their applications. Your unauthorized use of our patented technology without express permission from NNB constitutes patent infringement under U.S. patent laws.

DEMAND

1. **Immediate Cessation:** Cease and desist from manufacturing, distributing, marketing, and/or selling any product containing or related to our patented dihydroberberine formulations or any other infringing product.
2. **Removal from Sales Platforms:** Remove all listings and advertisements for the "Dihydroberberine +" product from your Amazon Store and any other sales channels within ten (10) business days of the date of this letter.
3. **Confirmation of Compliance:** Provide written confirmation within ten (10) business days of your compliance with the above demands, detailing the actions taken to cease infringement.

4. **Manufacturer and Distribution Details:** Disclose the name of any customers or other entities involved in the production or distribution of the infringing product.

CONSEQUENCES OF NON-COMPLIANCE

If we do not receive a satisfactory response and full compliance with this demand by November 30, 2024, NNB Nutrition will have no choice but to pursue all available legal remedies, including seeking an injunction and monetary damages for willful infringement. Additionally, any delay in compliance may expose your company to enhanced damages and legal costs.

We are willing to explore licensing opportunities if Nature's Fusions wishes to continue selling a dihydroberberine product under proper authorization from NNB Nutrition. Should you be interested in discussing a Trademark License and Supply Agreement with our exclusive manufacturer, please indicate your interest in your response.

We trust that you will comply with our demands promptly to avoid escalation of this matter.
