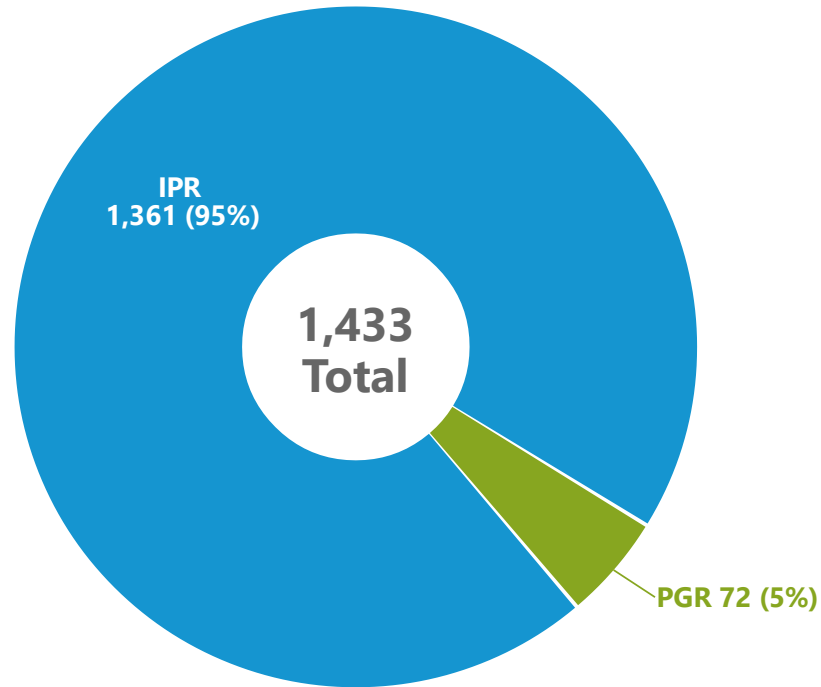

FY 25: Oct. 1, 2024 to Sep. 30, 2025

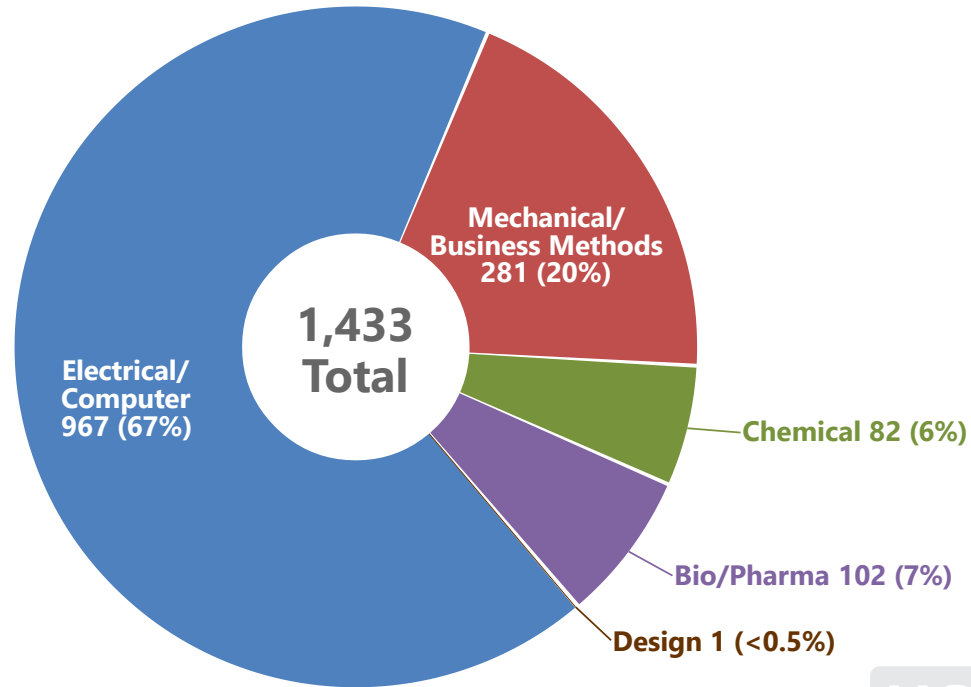


Trial types include Inter Partes Review (IPR) and Post Grant Review (PGR).



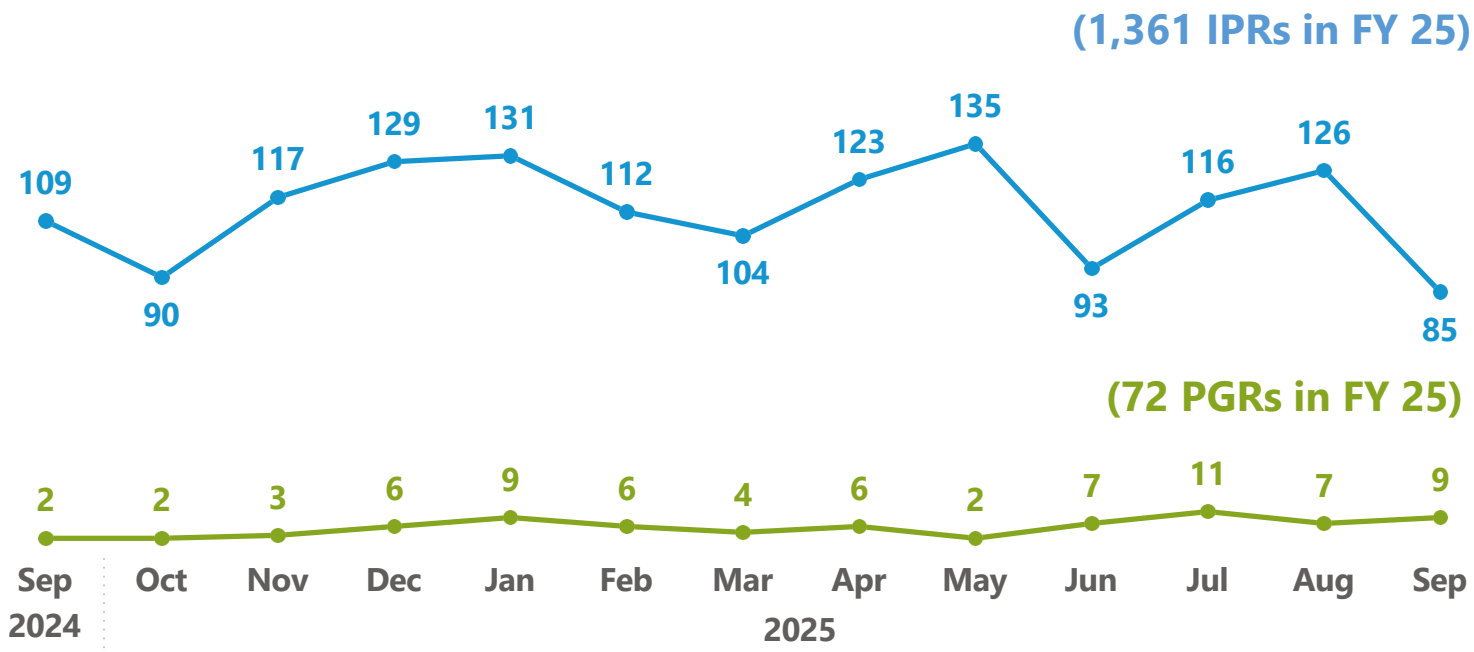
# Petitions filed by technology

FY 25: Oct. 1, 2024 to Sep. 30, 2025



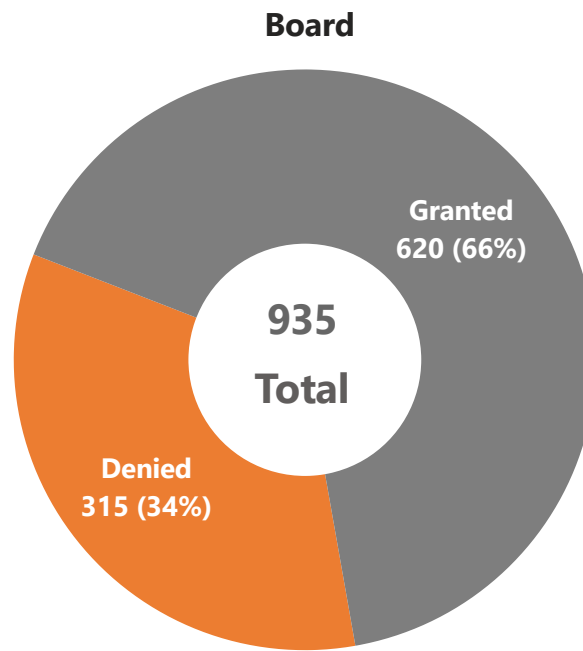
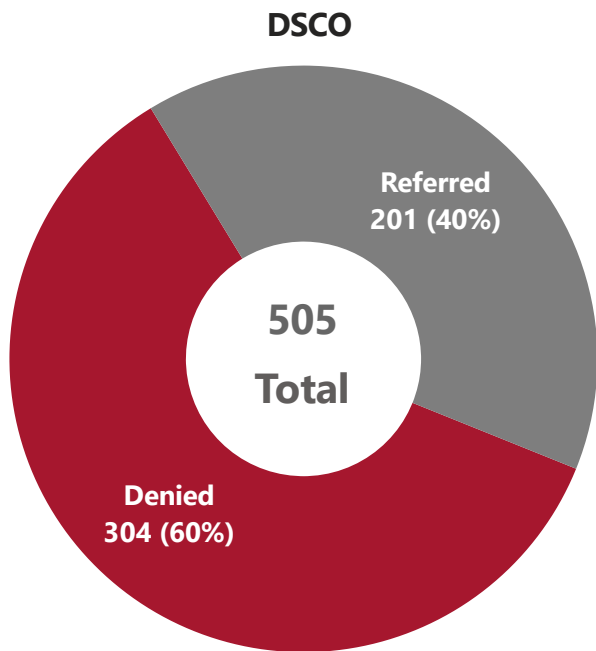
# Petitions filed by month

FY 25: Oct. 1, 2024 to Sep. 30, 2025

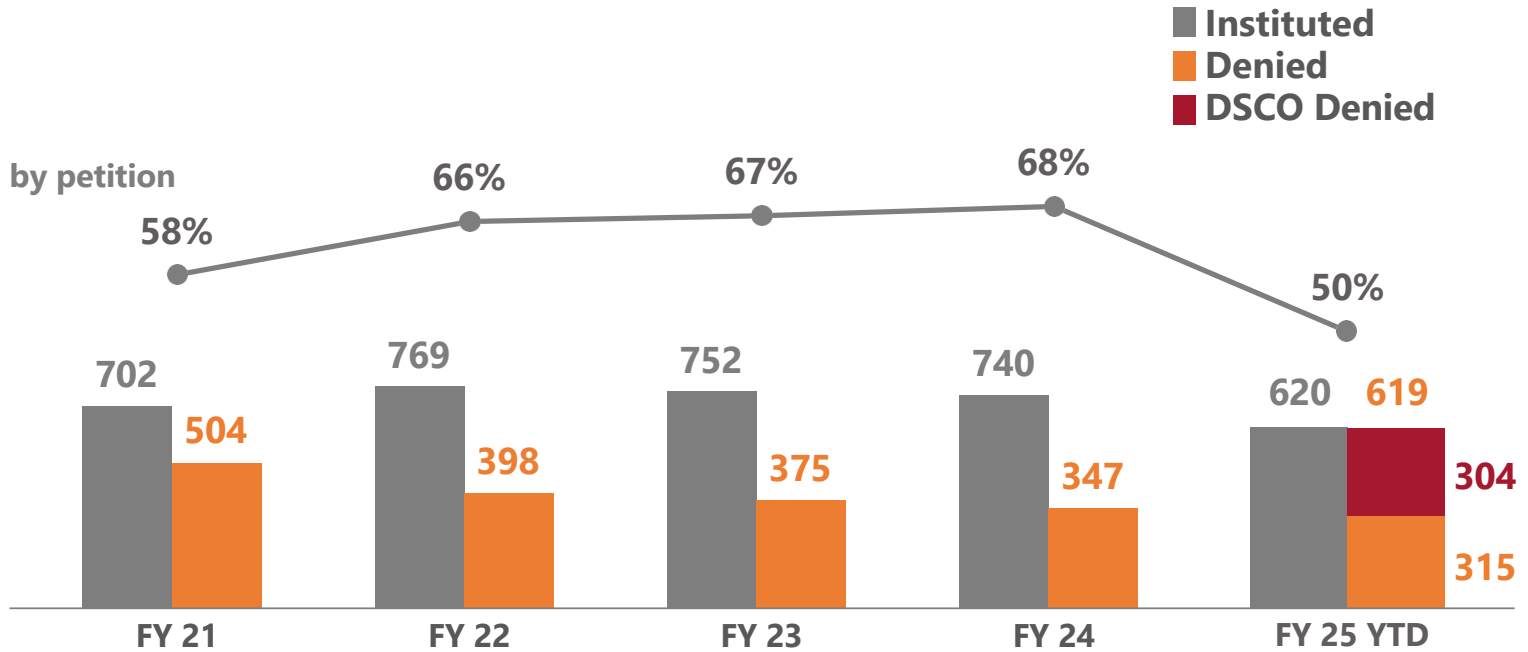

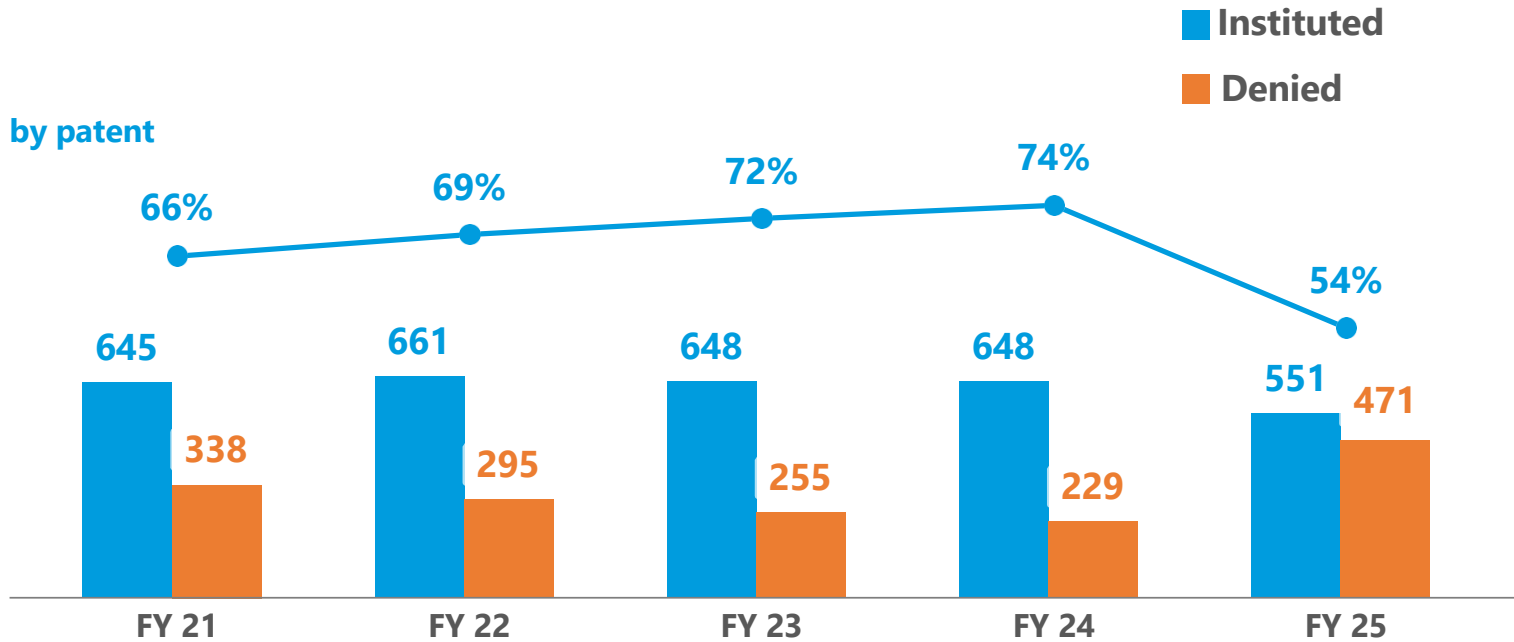
# Institution rates by petition

FY 21 to FY 25: Oct. 1, 2020 to Sep. 30, 2025



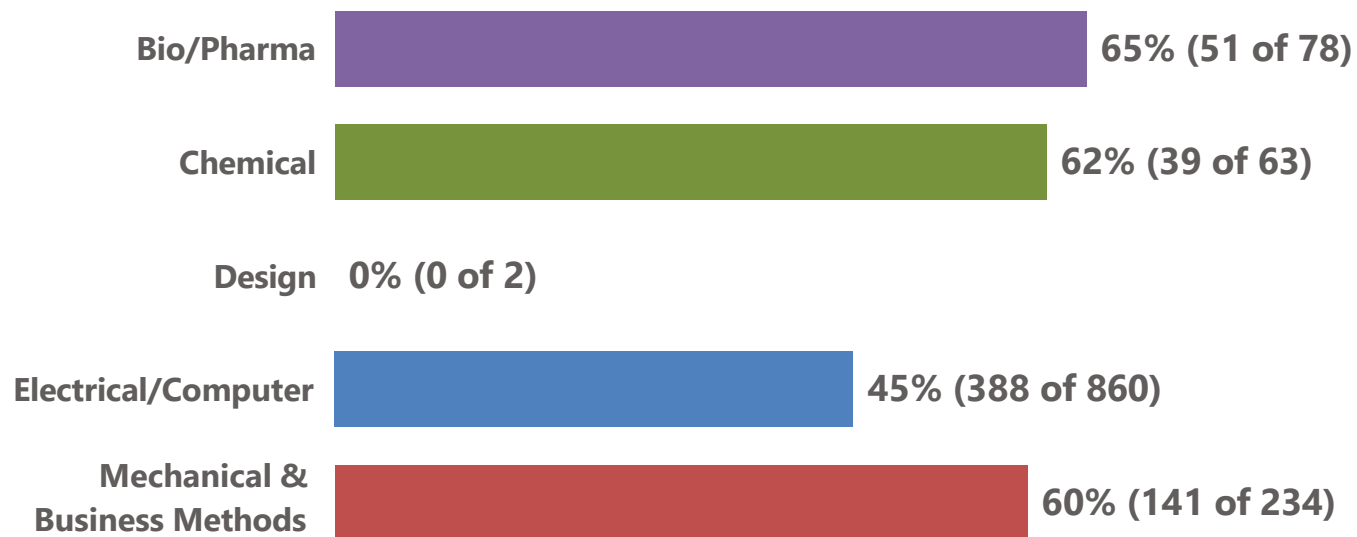
# Institution rates by patent

FY 25: Oct. 1, 2024 to Sep. 30, 2025

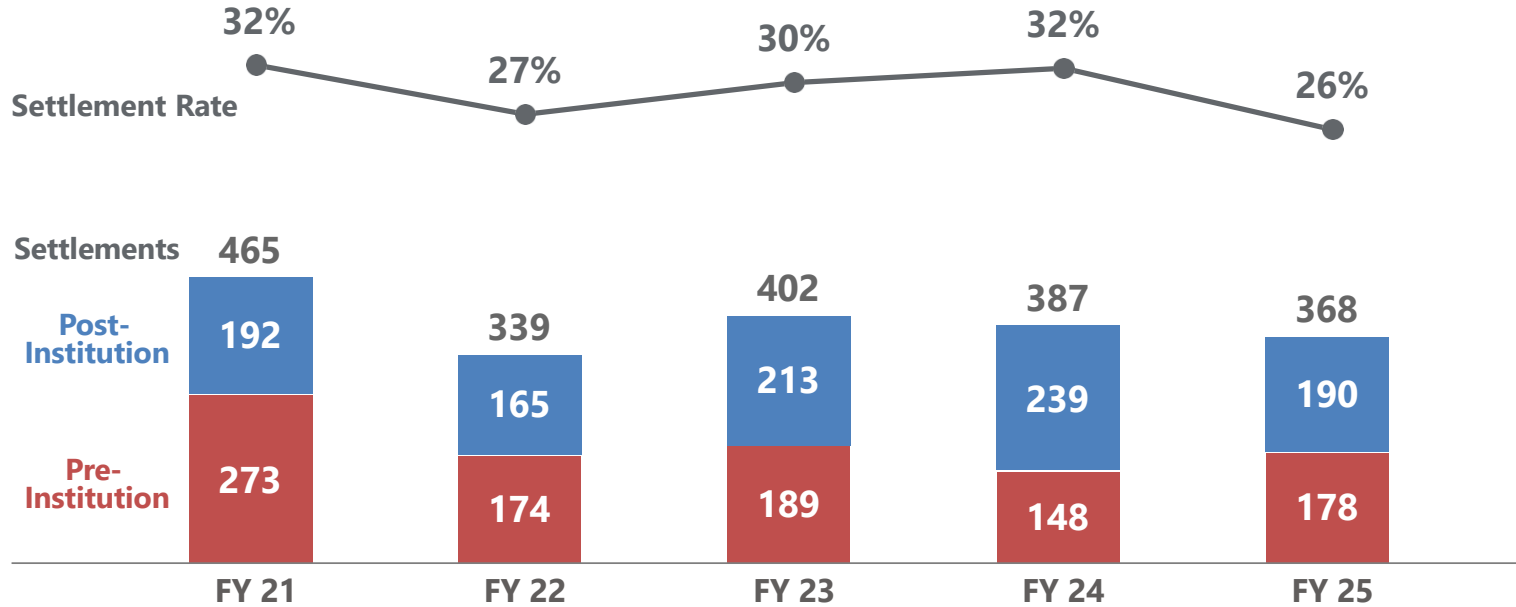

# Settlements

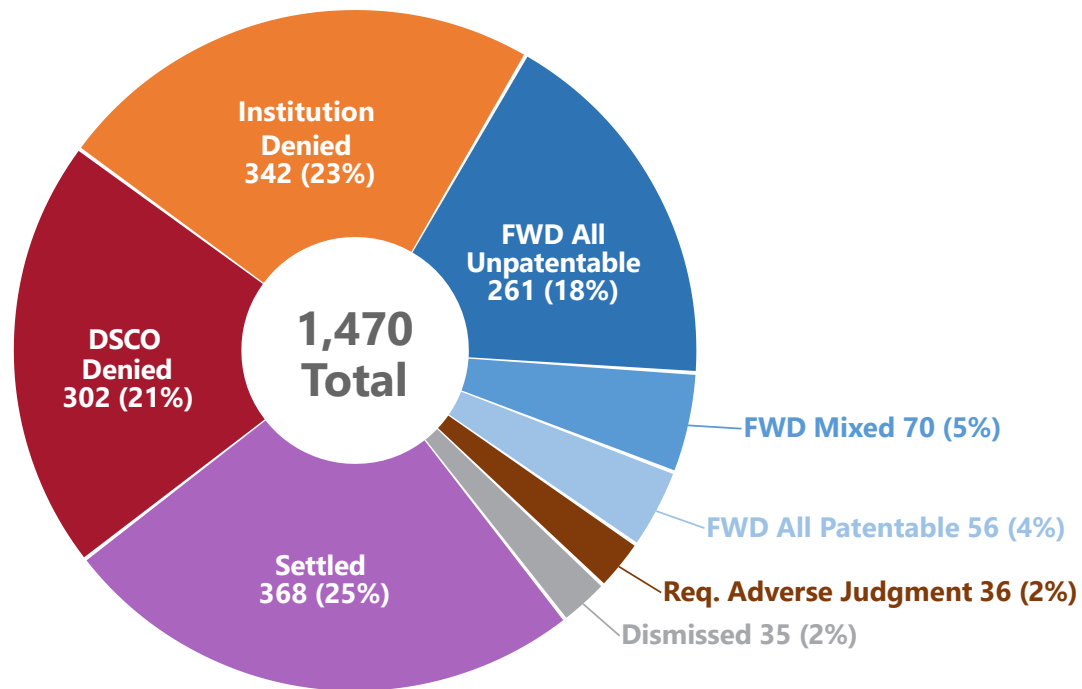
FY 21 to FY 25: Oct. 1, 2020 to Sep. 30, 2025



Settlement rate is calculated by dividing total settlements by concluded proceedings in each fiscal year (i.e., denied institution, settled, dismissed, requested adverse judgment, and final written decision), excluding joined cases.

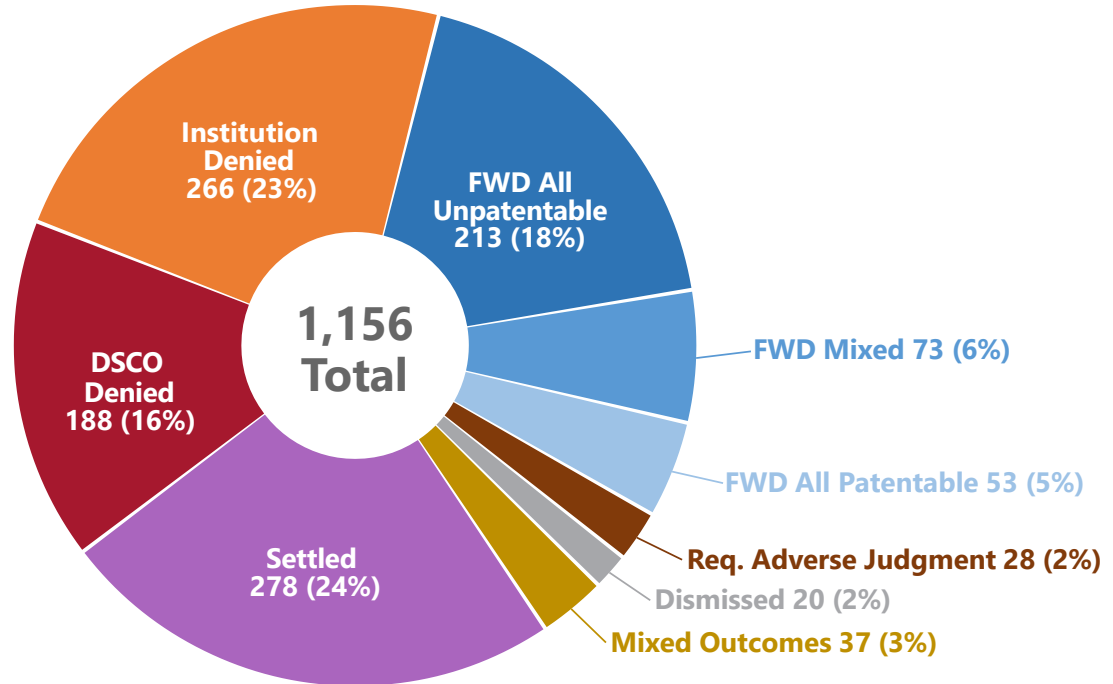
FY 25: Oct. 1, 2024 to Sep. 30, 2025

# Outcomes by patent

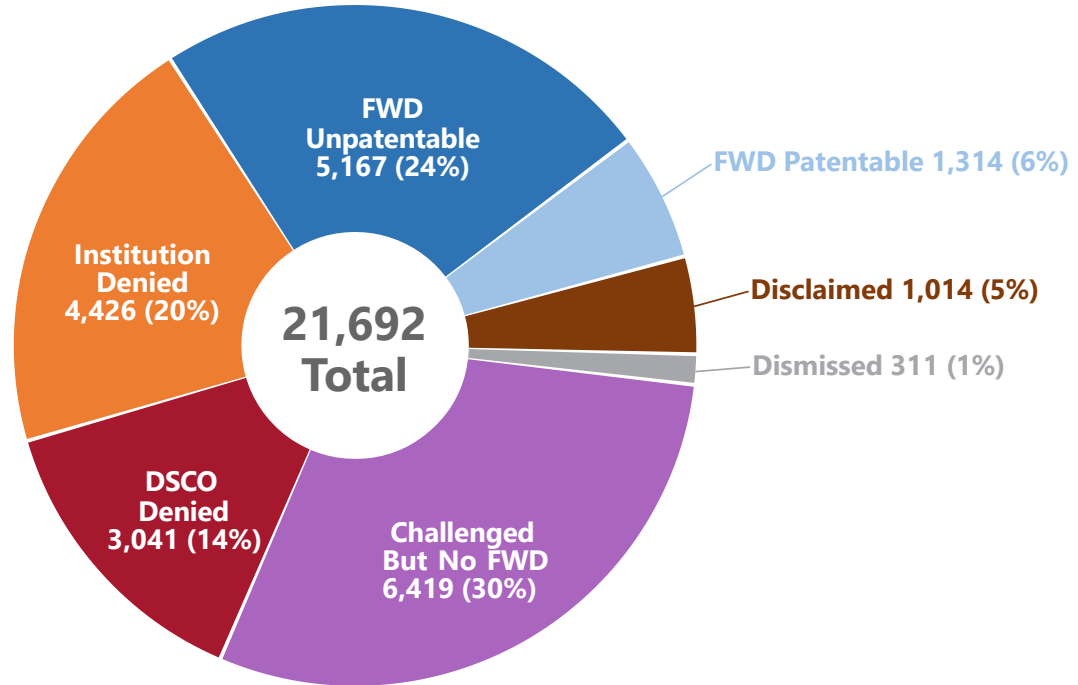

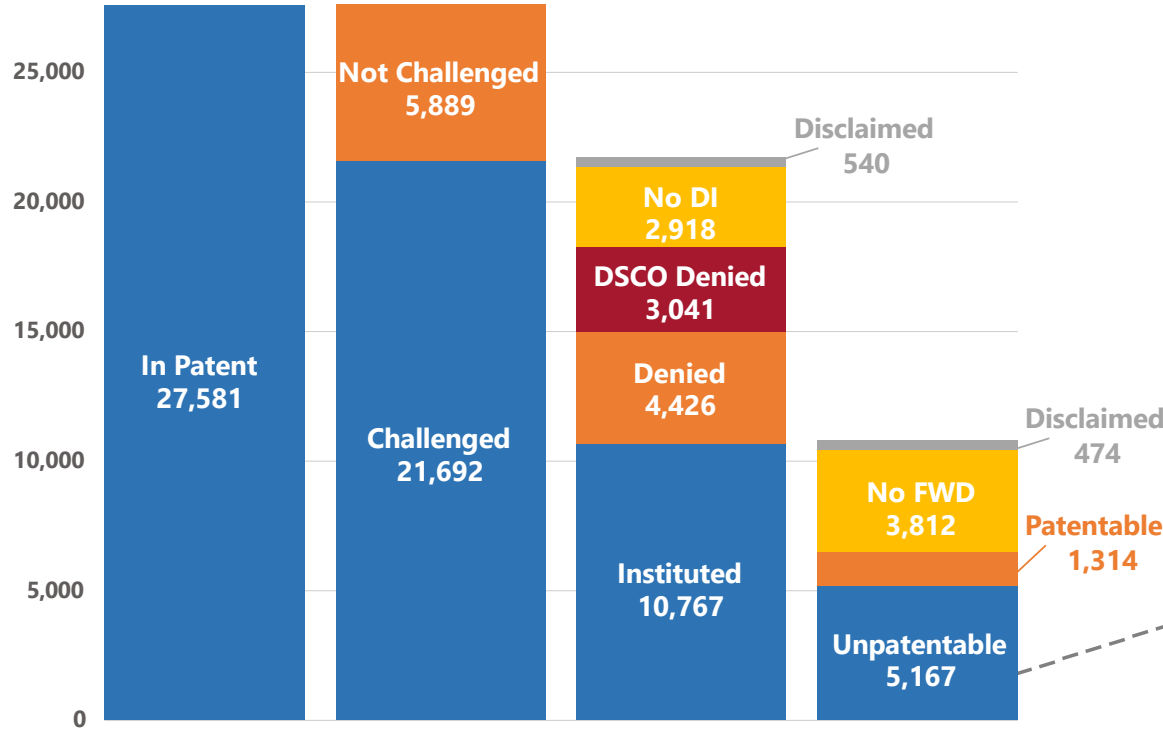
# Outcomes by claim challenged

“No DI” and “No FWD” mean the claim was challenged but not addressed in a DI/FWD, e.g., due to settlement.

24% of challenged claims and 48% of instituted claims were found unpatentable by a preponderance of the evidence.
