**ORDER NO. 11: INITIAL DETERMINATION AMENDING THE TARGET
DATE DUE TO THE PARTIES' REQUEST TO
RESCHEDULE THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING TO
LATER DATES**

(January 27, 2026)

On January 14, 2026, a Proposed Procedural Schedule was issued in this Investigation. (Order No. 4 (Jan. 14, 2026)). In that Proposed Procedural Schedule the evidentiary hearing (“Hearing”) was scheduled for October 28, 29, 30, November 2, November 3, and November 4, 2026. (*Id.* at 2–3.). The Proposed Procedural Schedule set April 2, 2027 as the deadline for the Final Initial Determination (“ID”) and August 2, 2027 as the Target Date. (*Id.*).

On January 22, 2026, Complainant Netlist, Inc. (“Complainant” or “Netlist”), Respondents Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd., Samsung Electronics America Inc., Samsung Semiconductor, Inc. (collectively “Samsung”), Google LLC (“Google”), and Super Micro Computer Inc. (“Super Micro”) (collectively, “Respondents” and, with Netlist, “the Private Parties”), and the Commission Investigative Staff (“Staff” and, with the Private Parties, “the Parties”) jointly moved (“Motion”) for a modification to the Hearing dates, and for an extension of time to submit their Proposed Procedural Schedule to fill in certain dates that the court had not selected. (Motion Dkt. No. 1472-005.).


According to their Motion, counsel for Samsung and counsel for Super Micro have conflicts with the Hearing dates that the court had selected. (Motion at 1.). The Parties selected later dates that are not possible given deadlines in other Investigations. However, to

accommodate in part the Parties' request to change the Hearing dates (to a later time) and to accommodate deadlines in pending Investigations, new Hearing dates have been selected. An Amended Proposed Schedule has been filed.

Accordingly, based upon the revised Hearing dates of November 23, 24, 30, December 1, 2, and 3, 2026, the ID is due no later than Monday, May 3, 2027. Therefore, the Amended Target Date will be Friday, September 3, 2027.

This Initial Determination is hereby certified to the Commission. Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(h), this Initial Determination shall become the determination of the Commission unless a party files a petition for review of the Initial Determination pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.43(a), or the Commission orders on its own motion a review of the Initial Determination or certain issues herein pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.44.
