**DECLARATION OF ERIC J. ENGER IN SUPPORT OF
PATENT OWNER'S DISCRETIONARY DENIAL BRIEF**

I, Eric J. Enger, declare as follows:

1. I am a partner with the law firm of Heim, Payne & Chorus, which represents Network-1 Technologies, Inc. in this matter and *Network-1 v. Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd., et al.*, No 2:25-cv-667 (E.D. Tex.) (the “District Court Proceeding”). I am admitted to practice law in Texas. I have personal, first-hand knowledge of the matters set forth herein and, if called to testify as a witness, I could and would testify competently thereto.

2. On September 30, 2025, Network-1 served its infringement contentions on Defendants in the District Court Proceeding. These contentions include 6 separate infringement charts spanning a combined 328 Pages.

3. On December 9, 2025, Defendants served their invalidity contentions on Network-1 in the District Court Proceeding. These contentions include 58 charts spanning a combined 4,547 pages.

4. In the District Court Proceeding, Network-1 has retained and is working with multiple experts to prepare for expert disclosures and trial.

5. In the District Court Proceeding, the parties in this litigation have served a combined 28 interrogatories, seven requests for admission, and nine subpoenas, including subpoenas to RPX; mobile network operators AT&T, T-Mobile, and Verizon; and five third party chipmakers who supply many components found in Defendants’ infringing devices including Qualcomm, NXP, Infineon, STMicro, and MediaTek. As of today, the parties have responded to a combined 28 interrogatories and 7 requests for admission.

6. In the District Court Proceeding, the parties have reviewed and produced over 80,000 pages of documents.
