MOTION TO SEAL AND REQUEST FOR IN CAMERA REVIEW
PURSUANT TO 37 C.F.R. § 42.14

Pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §§ 42.14 and the Director's November 17, 2025 Memorandum entitled *Voluntary Search Disclosure Declarations as a Favorable Factor in Institution Decisions* ("the Memorandum"), Petitioner requests that the Search Disclosure Declaration of Aron Berger ("the SDD"), filed as Filing Party and Board, be filed under seal and reviewed *in camera*. The contents of the SDD reflect the prior art search and review strategy of Petitioner and Petitioner's counsel. It is for precisely this reason that the Director's Memorandum expressly authorizes a petitioner to "file its SDD as Filing Party and Board, with a motion to seal and an accompanying request for in camera review under 37 C.F.R. § 42.14." Memorandum at 2. Per the Memorandum, the Office may use the information in the SDD for internal training, improving examination processes, and analytics.
